Church Fathers Speak "Run from hatred and cling to the love of the Lord." **Testaments of the twelve patriarchs**

Test Your Knowledge: Name the feast: The Holy Spirit descends on the apostles

- Pentecost

Last Week's Answer: Pentecost is not mentioned in the Gospel, but is recorded in the Acts of the Apostles.

10 Commandments: Man is in front of this crossroads: does God impose things on me, or take care of me? Are his commandments only a law, or do they contain a word? Is God a master or a father? Are we slaves, or children? This is a "battle" which takes place both inside and outside of the person, and is continually present: a thousand times we must choose between a slave mentality and a mentality of children; the Holy Spirit is a spirit of sons! A spirit of slaves can only

welcome the law in an oppressive way, and it can produce two opposite results: either a life of duties and obligations, or a violent reaction of rejection. 10 Commandments are words of Father to His sons and daughters; it presupposes dialogue and communication because they talk about truth and happiness.

Not every one that says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. **(Matthew 7:21)**.

"Now by this we know we know Him if we keep His commandments. He who says 'I know Him', and does not keep His commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him. He who says he abides in Him ought himself to walk just as He walked... These things I have written to you concerning those who try to deceive you" **(1 John 2:3-6,26)**

Exhort your household to learn the Ten Commandments word for word, that they should obey God... For if you teach and urge your families things will go forward.
