Last week's answer: The first Sunday after Pentecost commemorates All Saints.

Holy Spirit- "No one comprehends the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God." God's Spirit, reveals God, makes known to us Christ, his Word, his living Utterance. But the Spirit does not speak of Himself. The Spirit makes us hear the Father's Word, but we do not hear the Spirit himself. We know him only in the movement by which he reveals the Word to us and disposes us to welcome him in faith. The Spirit of truth who "unveils" Christ to us "will not speak on his own. "This explains why "the world cannot receive [him], because it neither sees

him nor knows him," while those who believe in Christ know the Spirit because he dwells with them. Holy Spirit is in the Church and manifests Himself in: Scriptures, Tradition, Church's Magisterium, sacramental liturgy, prayer, charisms and ministries, signs of apostolic and missionary life, witness of saints through whom he manifests his holiness and continues the work of salvation.

Catechism of the Catholic Church

I would say it simply: No one can give that which he doesn't personally possess, which means we cannot transmit the Holy Spirit in an effective way, render the Spirit perceptible, if we ourselves aren't close to the Spirit.
